

1910 CANADA 50 CENT : HOW TO TELL THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN AN EDWARDIAN LEAVES REVERSE AND A VICTORIAN LEAVES REVERSE (Page 1 of 2)



- It is relatively easy to tell the difference between these two varieties on coins where all of the detail can be seen. However, if you own lower grade coins where the rim is almost completely worn away, this method is next to impossible to use.
- Here we show a second method using angle of the top leaf, and it is useable with MUCH lower grade coins (down to approximately G-6):

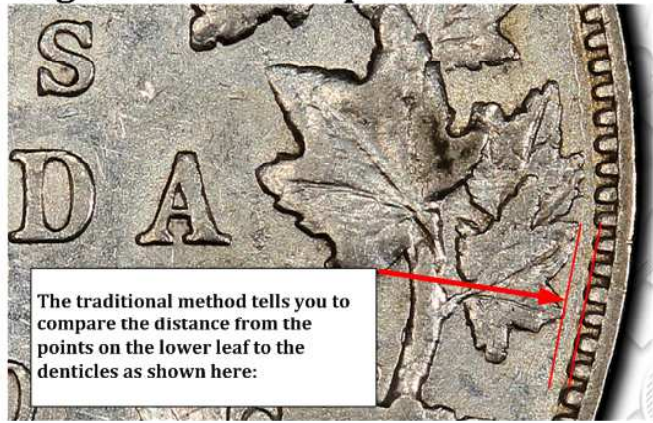


Figure 2a: Close-up view of leaves

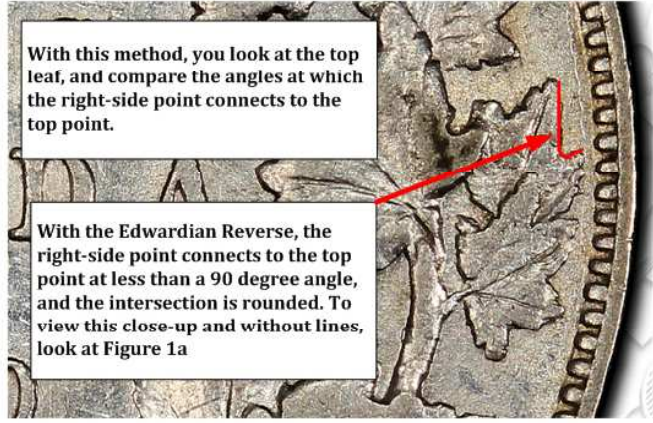


Figure 2b: Alternate Method 1
